

Travel grants

First of all, it may be difficult to obtain grants for study tours – but it is worth trying! It is possible to apply for grants for study tours, that are an integrated part of your studies; the two compact seminars in the first term (one of about two weeks and the other of about three to five days), two in the second (each about three to five days), and two in the third (each about three to five days).

Start applying for grants in plenty of time!

The list below consists of various travel grants for which students are entitled to apply.
